The person in the part-time faculty position teaches as much as 25 contact hours per week, including day or evening classes as necessary. He/She provides classroom and lab/shop instruction in an FAA Part 147 approved program for first and second year students working toward an FAA Certificate and/or Associate of Applied Science Degree in Aviation Systems Technology. Responsibilities include faculty duties as required. The Aviation Systems Instructor reports to the Department Chair, Aviation Systems Technology.

Qualifications:

- Associate Degree requires, Bachelor's degree preferred
- Airframe and Powerplant Certificate required
- Formal teaching experience in General, Airframe, and Powerplant curriculum required.
- Community College teaching experience is desirable

- Minimum of 5 years experience in military or civilian environment as a certified Airframe and Powerplant Technician is desirable
- Computer Competency required. Familiarity with Windows and Microsoft Office Products is desirable
- Commitment to Community College philosophy, and the integration of employability skills in to the program curriculum
- Ability to establish and maintain a positive, effective, working relationship with students, other faculty, staff, industry representative, advisory committee and the general public
