

Factors That Are Considered For Legal Residency For In-State Tuition

N.C. General Status 116-143

There is no automatic right to be classified as an in-state student. It is the student's burden to show the institution that (s)he is a legal resident and the standard of proof is the "preponderance of the evidence."

Please provide a minimum of 5 of the following documents along with the packet in order to be considered for in-state tuition.

- ✓ N.C. Driver's License
- ✓ Employment History
- ✓ Filing of Income Taxes as a N.C. Resident
- ✓ Voters Registration Card
- ✓ N.C. Auto Insurance
- ✓ N.C. Auto Registration
- ✓ N.C. Mortgage/Lease Agreements
- ✓ Ownership of Real Property in N.C.

*If you wish to provide more documents to prove N.C. Legal Residency, you may do so.

NOTE: An applicant of legal N.C. Residency for In-State Tuition purposes must be in the State of North Carolina for at least 12 months prior to the start date of the semester (s)he wishes to enroll.
