- Admissions Information -

Cosmetology is a limited enrollment program beginning fall and spring semester. Resources such as facilities, available space and faculty, limit the number of applicants accepted the program. All applicants must meet minimum requirements to be considered for the program and must be a High School/GED graduate. **Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee admission.**

All applicants must meet minimum requirements by the specified deadlines, in order to be considered as a qualified applicant for the program. Once the class has been filled, an alternate list of students will be identified. An alternate will be admitted to the program when an applicant originally accepted declines admission. **Alternates not admitted to the program and other applicants denied admission must re-apply if they wish to be considered for future seats.**

Admissions Process

- ___ 1. Submit GTCC application to Enrollment Services.
- ___ 2. Meet with an admissions advisor in Enrollment Services for an admissions interview.
- ___ 3. Complete the GTCC Placement Test, if required by the Admissions Office.
- ___ 4. Submit an official high school transcript or GED scores to Enrollment Services.
- ___ 5. Submit official transcripts from all colleges or schools attended since high school to Enrollment Services. These will be reviewed for possible transfer credit.
- ___ 6. After completion of the minimum admissions requirements, meet with an admissions advisor (by the deadline dates as listed above) to complete a Minimum Admissions Requirement Review - MAR. **This meeting is required.**

NOTE: Enrollment Service office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday and 9:00am to 5:00pm on Friday.

College English or math with a grade of “C” or higher may be used to waive some of the tests. Acceptable SAT/ACT scores within the past three years may also waive some of the tests.

If the placement test score(s) is below the minimum required for acceptance, an applicant must complete the appropriate developmental coursework as determined by an academic advisor. **All developmental writing and reading coursework must be completed before an applicant will be considered for admission to the Cosmetology program.** * Students may be accepted to the Cosmetology program with a Compass pre-algebra score of 26-46. **These students must complete MAT 060 during the first semester and pass the course with a grade of “C” or higher to continue.** Students scoring 47 or higher are exempt from this requirement.

2. After **completion** of the minimum requirements and the application process, applicants **must** meet with an admissions advisor to complete the Minimum Admissions Review (MAR) in order to be considered for admissions to the program. **This step must be completed by the deadline dates as indicated on the first page.** Applicants for the program will not be considered for admission to the Cosmetology program is completed.
