

III-1.051 Maximum Course Load

In the interest of student success, the maximum number of credit hours of course work that a student may take in any term without the approval of the department chair is twenty-one (21).

Procedure:

1. A student may enroll for up to twenty-one (21) credit hours of course work for which he/she is eligible and in which seats are available.
2. The department chair for the program in which the student is enrolled (or division chair in the absence of the department chair) must sign an approval for a student to take more than twenty-one (21) credit hours of course work in any term.
3. The twenty-one (21) hours is inclusive of developmental and audited courses.
