**PATTON TO TELL BEHIND THE SCENES STORY  
ABOUT THE WORLD’S TALLEST STRUCTURE**

JAMESTOWN – Steve Patton, department chair and professor of architectural technology on Guilford Technical Community College’s Greensboro campus, will be featured speaker for the college’s “Picturing America” series at 3 p.m. Wednesday, April 15.

The lecture, which is free and open to the public, will be held in room 325 of the Learning Resource Center on the Jamestown campus. His talk will be the third in a series sponsored by Friends of the Library. The May lecture will feature Margot Horney, who is coordinator of GTCC’s resource development.

Patton’s topic will be “Chrysler Building: The Behind the Scenes Story of the World’s Tallest Building, 1930-31.”
