### **JAMES R. LEWIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED TO THREE CULINARY STUDENTS**

JAMESTOWN – Eastern Food Equipment Co. in Winston-Salem has awarded \$3,600 in memorial scholarships to three culinary students at Guilford Technical Community College.

Carmen Vaquera of Greensboro received \$2,500, the top award under the James R. Lewis Memorial Scholarships established by the company. Lewis was one of the original owners of the 17-year-old business. He passed away in 2007. Thomas Hamberis is the sole owner of the company.

Brittany Guy and Katherine Orell, both of Greensboro, received \$550 each.
