**FORMER LAWYER TURNED TEACHER
WILL SPEAK ON CONSTITUTION DAY**

JAMESTOWN – Richard Rawls of Greensboro, a former trial lawyer who teaches history and civics at Grimsley High School, will be the featured speaker at Constitution Day at Guilford Technical Community College. The one-hour presentation “Paying the Piper: Constitution and the National Debt,” will begin at 7 p.m. Thursday, Sept. 17, in the Sears Applied Technology building auditorium on the Jamestown campus.
