## \*Crime Stoppers Alert\*

1. **Hit and Run** - On August 5, 2008, a 1998 Infiniti was parked in lot D on the Jamestown Campus. While the owner was in class, an unknown person struck the front passenger door, causing damage. The estimated damage is \$700.00. The suspect vehicle is possibly white in color.
2. **Larceny and Damage to Real Property** – On August 5, 2008, it was reported to Police that an unknown person(s) had removed the lighted signs from 1111 South Main St., High Point Campus. The removal of the sign caused property damage.
3. **Larceny** – On August 12, 2008, it was reported to Police that an unknown person(s) took a *Taigmans Advanced Cardiology* book from Cube 234 at the Public Safety Building on the Jamestown Campus. Estimated loss is \$39.00.
4. **Breaking and Entering of a Coin Operated Machine (Vending Machine)** – On August 14, 2008, it was reported to Police that unknown person(s) broke into the vending machine located in the Break Room in the Applied Tech. 7. **Hit and Run** - On August 21, 2008, a 2007 Ford was parked in lot B on the Jamestown Campus. While the owner was in class, an unknown person struck the front bumper, causing damage. The estimated damage is \$1500.00.
