Crime Stoppers Alert September 2009

1. **Larceny** - On September 1, 2009, it was reported to Police that unknown person(s) went in the Welding Building on the Jamestown Campus and took a green Motorola Blackberry phone from one of the desks. The larceny occurred sometime before 2:00pm. The estimated loss is \$300.00. There are no suspects or witnesses at time of report.
2. **Breaking, Entering and Larceny from a Motor Vehicle** – On September 8, 2009 it was reported to Police that a Chevrolet Sprint was broken into while parked in parking lot E on the Jamestown Campus. Person(s) unknown entered the unlocked vehicle and stole a Garmin 330 Street Pilot from the glove box. This larceny occurred sometime between 7:15am and 11:00am.
