Crime Stoppers Alert November 2008

1. **Property Damage** - On October 27, 2008 an unknown person damaged the wall in the lobby (parking lot side) of the Adult Education Building on the Greensboro Campus. This damage occurred sometime between 4:00pm and 7:30pm and was a hole about the size of a softball. The estimated damage is \$150.00.
2. **Larceny** - On November 6, 2008 it was reported to Police that unknown person(s) had stolen a license tag from a 1992 Honda while parked in the parking lot at the Greensboro Campus. This larceny occurred sometime between 9:30am and 12:30pm, the stolen tag is: WTP-6246.
3. **Breaking and Entering and Larceny from a Motor Vehicle** - On November 7, 2008, it was reported to Police that unknown person(s) broke into a Red, 1997 Mitsubishi Mirage while parked in the parking lot on the Jamestown Campus. The perpetrator entered the vehicle and stole a portfolio containing 4 limited edition prints. Three of the prints were of Barack Obama (#272 of 1000, #3807 of 5000 and #2939 of 5000) and one of the prints was of Hillary Clinton. There was also Discman CD player, 25 blank CDs and \$10.00 in cash taken. The estimated loss is \$300.00.
4. **Property Damage** - On November 10, 2008 it was reported to Police that a black 2004 Suzuki vehicle was damaged while parked in parking lot J on the Jamestown Campus. The locks on the driver's side door and passenger door were punched and caused the locks to fall inside the door of the vehicle. This damage occurred sometime between 8:55am and 1:30pm. There are no suspects or witnesses at this time. Estimated damage is \$200.00.
5. **Assault** - On November 10, 2008 an unknown group of students were sitting on the wall in front of the Applied Tech. Building on the Jamestown Campus and began calling another student names and throwing mulch at this student. Names of the group of students are not known at this time but are described as young, black males.
6. **Larceny** - On November 11, 2008 at approximately 2:00pm an unknown person stole a Black Sony PSP while plugged into a laptop in the Cafeteria Area on the Jamestown Campus. The owner stated that the PSP was left unattended for about 10 minutes and when he returned, the PSP was gone. There was also a screen saver with a pelican on it, white skull candy headphones and a disc with five episodes of *Family Guy*. The estimated total loss is \$200.00.
7. **Property Damage** - On November 11, 2008, it was reported to Police that unknown person(s) damaged a White, 1992 Honda Civic while parked in lot G on the Jamestown Campus. The damage was to the driver's side window where it appeared that a rock, BB or something of that nature hit the window and shattered it. This damage occurred sometime between 12:50pm and 3:25pm. The estimated damage is \$250.00.
8. **Larceny** - On November 11, 2008, it was reported to Police that a NEC VT800 Projector was taken from the Auditorium of the Applied Tech. Building. Estimated loss is \$800.00.
9. **Property Damage** - On November 12, 2008 it was reported to Police that an unknown person(s) broke the window out of the passenger door of a 1999 blue Dodge Durango. This damage occurred sometime between 9:30am and 12:30pm in the parking lot on the Greensboro Campus.
10. **Larceny** - On November 14, 2008, it was reported to Police that unknown person(s) stole a Blue Cricket Slider Cell Phone from the Student Lounge in the Medlin Campus Center on the Jamestown Campus. This larceny occurred at approximately 10:45am. Estimated loss is \$50.00.
