

CRITERIA AND DESCRIPTION OF CURRICULUM AWARD

Academic Awards (Students do not apply)

The purpose of this award is to honor students in each curriculum that has/have the highest cumulative GPA and meets the following minimum criteria:

1. Have been enrolled in two of the last four terms (Spring 2006, Summer 2006, Fall 2006 and Spring 2007).
2. Have completed at least 20 credit hours at GTCC 10 of which are major course hours in their current degree program or 10 credit hours at GTCC in a diploma program.
3. Has (have) the highest program GPA of anyone enrolled in the curriculum. The GPA must be a minimum of 3.5.

Curriculum Awards (Students do not apply)

Each department will choose a student in each degree program who is both outstanding in his/her academic achievement and has potential for success in the particular field he/she has chosen. To be eligible for consideration, students must meet the following criteria:

1. Have been enrolled in two of the last four terms (Spring 2006, Summer 2006, Fall 2006 and Spring 2007).
2. Have completed at least 20 credit hours at GTCC 10 of which are major courses in their current degree program or 10 credit hours at GTCC in a diploma program.
3. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
4. Have participated in departmental and campus activities and have demonstrated expertise in the field of study.

Outstanding Graduate Awards (Students must apply)

1. Must have graduated in December 2006 or be graduating in May 2007 or August 2007.
2. Have at least a 3.0 grade point average.
3. Demonstrate leadership and good citizenship.

President's Medal (Students must apply)

1. Recognizes the most outstanding graduate of the year.
2. Must have graduated in December 2006 or be graduating in May 2007 or August 2007.
3. Have at least a 3.5 grade point average.
4. Show leadership and good citizenship.
