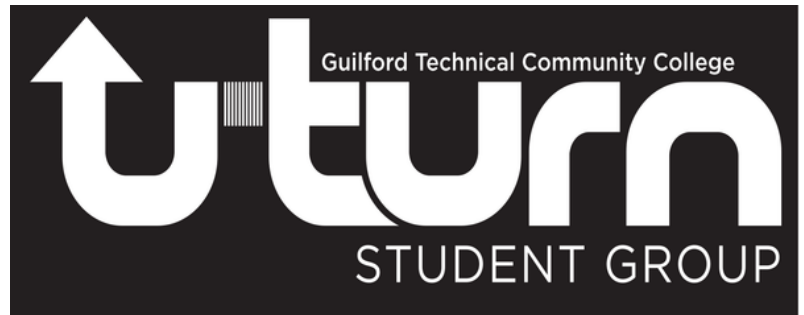

### **GTCC UTURN Club**

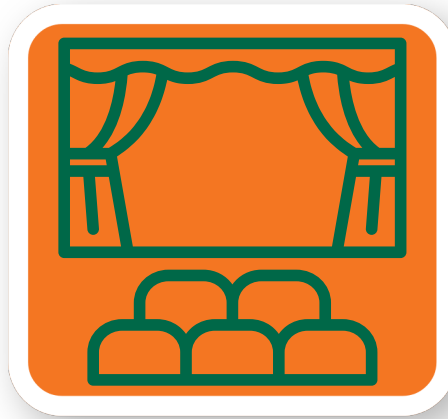
UTURN supports Titans with awareness, prevention, and recovery resources for substance use. The club reduces stigma, promotes wellness, and creates a safe space for open conversations.

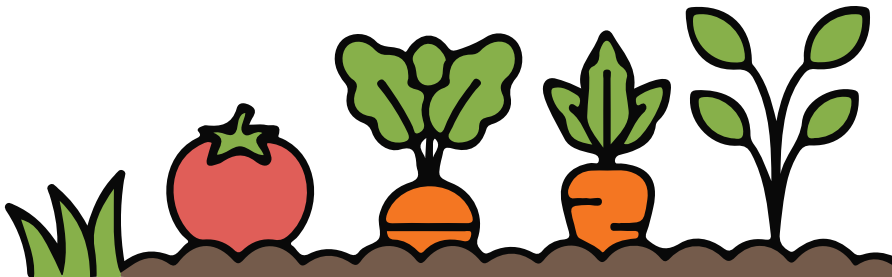
