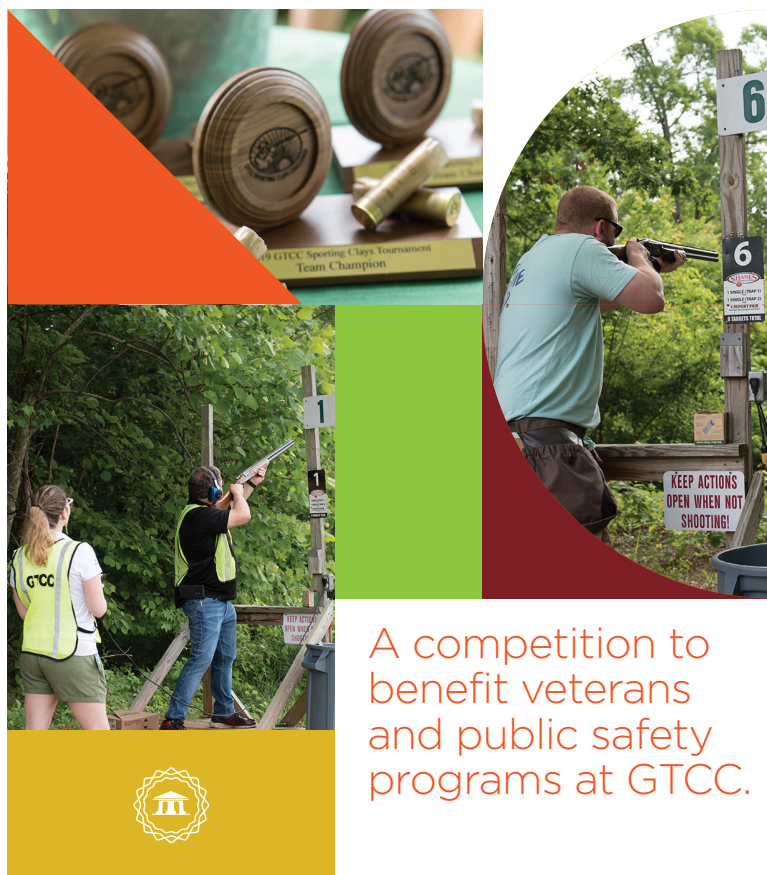

### Event Information

The GTCC Sporting Clays Challenge was created in 2014 to provide scholarships, services, and opportunities to benefit students who are military veterans and students in our public safety educational programs at GTCC, including basic law enforcement, criminal protection, and emergency medical service (EMS).

You may have heard of sporting clays referred to as "golf with a shotgun," and that's a fair comparison. Like golf courses, no two sporting clays courses are alike, the terrain and background have a lot to do with how targets are presented. Since no two courses are alike, shooters travel to different courses to experience variety.

This event will feature a morning shoot with a 14-station course and is open to six teams of four. Participants will enjoy an exciting event, the chance to network and promote their business, and the opportunity to help raise money for important public safety programs at GTCC, our area's main trainer for police, fire, and EMS professionals.
